PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Well the time has finally come, the year is at an end, the squash season is winding down and the time has come for me to write my final report.

The year has been a one of steady as she goes, so from the Boards perspective it has been a very quiet year with the same old problems trying to find funding for programmes to promote the game throughout the District and more at club level development.

Funding criteria is hard to keep up with as it is almost changing every time we apply with a lot of the trusts not funding long term or repeated costs. So from a high when the District was receiving 100k a year we are now lucky to receive 20k. The Lion Foundation, Pub Charity and NZCT, have been Central's main funders. Central received sponsorship from InspireNet for the Junior Elite program, Prince for the player's series and Sport Manawatu for the coaching of coaches.

Squash New Zealand's funding this year has been a push towards Club Development and result based. Ann Brouwers has worked very hard to get a plan together and approved by SNZ involving four clubs around the district. Next year the funding program will change again to a pool base of 165k for projects or programmes that will develop or promote squash. This will be on a first in basis with no limit. So the incoming Board will have to work quickly to identify a project or program and get a plan in place if it wants funding from SNZ.

Dave Clarke (SNZ Coaching Director) and I have been working through the year on getting the three sport trusts to work together in funding a Squash Coach Force coach for the district to implement Squash New Zealand's coaching program. This has not worked out as each sport trust seems to be going in different directions. Dave is still talking to sports Manawatu and Taranaki on having a part time coach force coach in each area for next year.

I was pleased to be able to attend the inaugural New Zealand Squash Hall of Fame dinner in Auckland at last year's SNZ AGM, when one of Central and Palmerston North's founding Fathers ROY HADDON was inducted to the Hall of Fame for his contribution to New Zealand Squash throughout the 50's and 60's.

Again this year Central has been recognised for its ability to host National events with SquashGym Palmerston running the National C Grade Super Champ Finals and Kawaroa Park hosting the New Zealand Masters and teams event. Well done to both clubs. Along with this I wish SquashGym Palmerston all the success with their upcoming world women's team squash championship, their second world event in four years.

To the board of directors, the management teams that support them and Sharon the district administrator my thanks to you all for a great job well done. This year has run well and your efforts have made my job very easy and a pleasure. Alistair, I wish you all the best in the path you choose in the future and hope that you prosper from your choices.

As I said at the start of my report this is my last one. After a decade as Centrals President and some twelve years prior on the Central committee I am standing down. In my time the district has been through some highs and lows, with big changes to the way we operate, good times, bad times but in the end, Central has been a great association to be involved with. I have met and worked with a lot of great people and have made a lot of friends. I wish the incoming President and Board all the best for the future.

To all of the squash community have a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year and I hope to see you all around somewhere.

FINANCE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Considering the tough economic climate in 2010 Central squash's finances ended up on the right side of the ledger at year end.

There is a surplus in the accounts of \$6,879 (2009 \$14,895) and whilst this has dropped from 2009 we have managed to consolidate our cash position even further ending the year with cash in the bank of \$66,000 (2009 \$55,800).

Once again income has steadily dropped this year, mainly due to the cessation of funding from Squash NZ, but we were fortunate once again to receive grants totalling \$10,000 during the year. Sharon Patterson works tirelessly throughout the year to secure as much funding as is possible and once again we must thank all the funders who have continued to support us being Lion Foundation, NZ Community Trust and Pub Charities.

Expenses for the year have remained reasonably static which has helped us to manage the finances without any nasty surprises and even though we are still employing a user pays system for most programs we have been able to minimise the costs for the user during the year.

The Prince Series was not well supported in 2010 and the board feel that it has run its course in the present format. The board will be looking at new ways to run this series in the future, hopefully with the continued support of Prince. Sport Manawatu continued their support for the coaching of coaches programmes and InspireNet was back on board with their sponsorship of the InspireNet Junior squad, the members of this squad continue to excel on the squash court with another year of fantastic results.

Debtors collection continues to be a struggle although outstanding amounts in 2010 \$14,786 (2009 \$23,015) have decreased markedly. Some clubs in 2009/10 have started up monthly AP's to clear the outstanding balances, which can be helpful for cashflow, small amounts often are sometimes better than one large amount every 6 months. Something for the clubs who are struggling to think about, it certainly makes my life easier not having to chase up outstanding amounts all the time.

Once again affiliation fees will remain the same for 2011. Going forward the board will have to look at this closely at the end of 2011 as there have been no increases for three years. As costs continue to rise, we must adjust our fees accordingly to keep pace, otherwise we will not continue as successfully in the next few years.

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Central Squash Association Incorporated is a reporting entity for the purposes of the Financial Reporting Act 1993. The financial statements of the Central Squash Association Incorporated have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993

Central Squash Association Incorporated is an incorporated club. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

MEASUREMENT BASE

The accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of earnings and financial position on a historical basis are followed by the entity.

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of financial performance and the financial position have been applied

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

Accounts receivable are stated at their net realisable value.

INVENTORIES

Inventories are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, on a first in-first out basis

FIXED ASSETS

All fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation to date.
Depreciation has been provided at the maximum rates permitted by the Income Tax Act 1994

CONDITIONAL GRANTS

Grants received are recognised as income unless the specific conditions attached to them are not met. In these cases the grants are shown as a liability until the conditions are met

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

The financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis with the exception of accounts receivable and accounts payable which are shown GST inclusive

CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES

There have been no changes in accounting policies during the year. All policies have been applied on a consistent basis with previous years.
